some type of dating violence*

Teen dating is a critical component in adolescent development. These relationships help teens gain the experience that they need for future relationships. They learn about compromising, companionship, love, trust, respect, and intimacy.

However, often teen dating can be a negative experience. Dating violence and abuse have become widespread problems in our culture. About 1 in 3 teens have experienced some type of dating violence or abuse.

This complex issue is often minimized, misunderstood, or neglected. Often adults are unaware or overlook the presence of abuse in teen dating. Teens are more likely than adults to hide the abuse and become isolated and not seek the help they need.

As professionals and parents who work with youth we need to listen, educate, support, and create a culture of intolerance for teen dating violence.

During this informative four hour session we will:

- * Review up-to-date statistics
- * Discuss and dispel myths and misconceptions about teen dating violence and abuse
- * Understand why teens stay in abusive relationships and why they abuse
- * Recognize warning signs
- * Explore the new world of digital dating violence
- * Learn how to address the rights and responsibilities in a relationship
- * Determine how we, as professionals and parents can be a part of the solution.

This training will assist teachers in the disciplines of Health, Physical Education and Family Consumer Science to meet NYS Education Standards 1,2, and 3.
